





STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

SUPPORT FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PEOPLE

Aboriginal support officers are available to assist Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander learners with enrolment, course selection, employment opportunities, and can arrange study support.

ACCESSIBILITY AND DISABILITY SERVICES

TAFE NSW provides a range of accessibility and disability support services to assist you with your enrolment and learning, and to make your time at TAFE NSW as rewarding as possible.



PERSONAL COUNSELLING

TAFE NSW students are able to meet with a counsellor to discuss any study or personal matters, completely free of charge. Counsellors can also refer you to other legal, health or financial services.

VOCATIONAL COUNSELLING
