
Student Subject Selection


Easy to Follow Steps

Once registered there will be a black head in the top right hand side.


2. Now select My Subjects.




3. Now show your students the slide show here. It will cover the main rules of the HSC and gives advice on how to best select subjects that suit your students.




4. Now ask your students to select a career they like from the left hand side.



5. What will appear is an orange box and in bold white type are the suggestions of the assumed knowledge or recommended HSC subjects. This will be useful as a starting point for your students to then talk to you, their parents, teachers and other senior students who have done these subjects.



6. For students considering University study, select My ATAR.



- 7. Now they enter the ATAR they hope to achieve.
- 8. Then they select the career field they wish to head towards.



9. They find a course that interests them and they click on the 6 digit blue course code on the left hand side.
