The Mathematics Key Learning Area Coordinator is also an excellent teacher in terms of knowledge of content, teaching methodology, classroom management, methods of evaluation and professional development. Applicants must have the necessary skills and experience to maximise student outcomes within a 1:1 personal device learning environment.

Support of the values of a Catholic school conducted in the traditions of Edmund Rice is imperative, as is a willingness to participate in the co-curricular life of the College.
