The UCAS personal statement is the UK's equivalent of the US college essay. Except where US colleges provide a prompt to applicants and the essay needs to speak about specific details, the format of the UCAS personal statement is far more open and standardized. The personal statement is your opportunity to show what you're like, to talk about your interests and to demonstrate your commitment to your chosen course. You should spend time fine-tuning this one document, as it could be the difference acceptance and rejection.
