By attending the HSC Enrichment Day (next message mentioned below), you can have the option to sit a 60 minute exam with the unique opportunity to secure an early offer into our Geography or Society & Culture related degrees. This exam will expect students to apply knowledge that they have learnt during the day and in class. Please note, we do not expect students to study for this exam prior as the focus is mainly on the content provided to them on the day as well as their ability to satisfactorily respond to exam style questions.
