Applicants must be innovative and have demonstrable ICT skills, be supportive of the Catholic ethos of the community and be willing to participate in the co-curricular life of the College.

This is a permanent full-time position commencing in January 2020. Applicants will be subject to Employment Screening as required by the Child Protection Act. A commitment to the ethos of the Catholic School is essential.
