Task: Remove litter from the mangroves of Erina Bay

Report:

- Peak high tide allowed access to Erina Bay with the mangroves on the Green Point side first surveyed with masses
 of small litter present as a direct result of the recent storms. Soft plastic, plastic bottles and plenty of balls in the
 100 metres of mangroves cleaned.
- Swarms of mosquitoes made the challenge difficult, but with plenty of repellent, and good motivation the task was completed. A mattress, tyre, marine ply, larger polystyrene the only larger items found. 15 very full bags were removed, the boys often on hands and knees to retrieve the litter.
- Mozzies chased the team out of Erina Bay, with a re-group near the Punt Bridge where again bulk litter was found, but only near the bridge. Further into the mangroves the tidal water has 'washed" the mangroves clean. It is this litter that has generated further into the Bay or perhaps into Erina Creek.
- A sunken fibreglass vessel was found off the Punt Bridge, with all of the boys into the water, flipping the boat over.
 Simon hooked up a rope and with a slow tow the boat was returned to St Eddies Jetty, where another big lift by the boys had the vessel close to the shore line. The new landcruiser then towed it up the bank and it was again flipped onto the trailer.
- All collected litter was placed under the vessel with the load towed to Woy Woy Tip for disposal.
- Outstanding effort by the students and supervising teacher.

Bags of litter collected = 15 plus bulk Weight of litter collected = 480 kilos Council Disposal Fee: \$17.76

Education Learning Outcomes:

- Environmental impact of plastic in the mangroves highlighted to the boys through progression to micro plastics
- Don't go into the mangroves without insect repellent (for those who read this report)

Recommendations:

• Continue the Erina Bay and Creek clean-up

Expenditure: barge operator fee, coordinator fee, disposal fee, disposal transport, volunteers lunch


