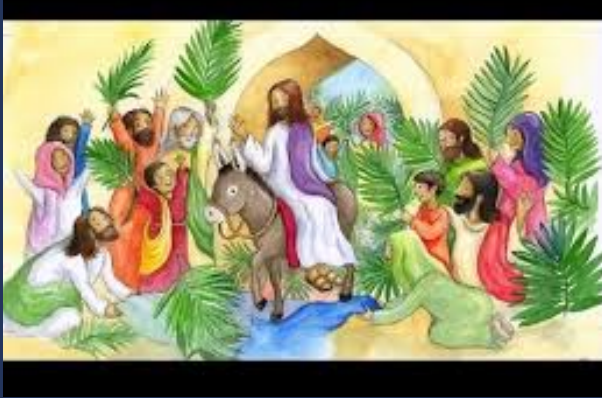


Storyboard of the Life of Jesus and his Journey
