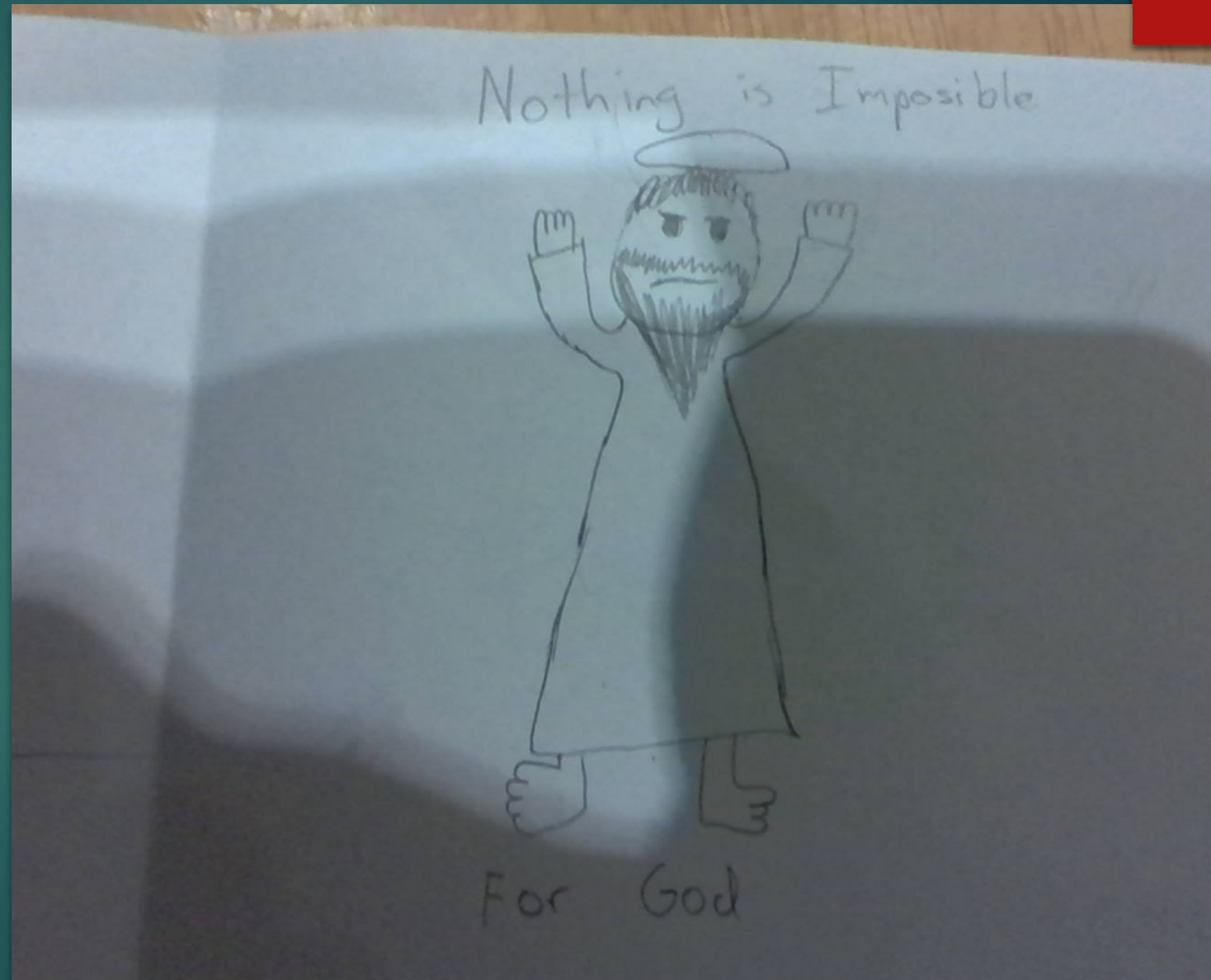
Love one another as I have loved you
