The role is a job share position sharing a teaching load with an experienced teacher four days per week (Monday to Thursday). The successful candidate will be a contemporary practitioner with qualifications and experience in teaching English across Stages 4 – 6 and HSIE across Stages 4 -5 and Religious Education in Stages 4 and 5.

The successful applicant will work within a team of professional staff in a technology-rich learning environment. Applicants must be innovative and have demonstrable ICT skills, be supportive of the Catholic ethos of the community and be prepared to participate in the co-curricular life of the College.

- Demonstrates competence and confidence in the effective use of technologies to enhance student learning in a one-to-one learning environment.
- Can demonstrate an excellent understanding of contemporary educational research including the John Hattie's Visible Learning pedagogical approaches to enhance student learning.
- Demonstrates an ability to relate positively with students, staff and parents and a willingness to work in a collaborative team.
- Ability and willingness to contribute to co-curricular activities.
