Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to all the Year 7 students and families as well as all our other year groups and their families. We look forward to another great year of competition for St Eddies' teams and individuals in both School-based and External-based events/competitions. Fingers crossed that 2022 will give students more opportunities this year.

Currently, the various platforms for Representative Sport (BBSSA, CSNSW, NSW All Schools and School Sport Australia) are determined that Inter-School Sport will return to some sort of normal. This however will be guided by individual sporting associations and sports around any restrictions that might be in place at the time of a sporting competition/event. We will aim to keep you updated via our permission notes and the College Newsletter.

Students will be reminded at Year Meetings to take note of the daily notices for sporting team information regarding when they need to attend meetings/training/selection trials. Depending on the Sport, Age Group and number of players trying out, Selection Trials will be run during lunchtime or after school to hopefully give all students an opportunity to be selected in the team. However, it is a Representative team, and in some Sports/Events, we are limited in the number of players/teams we can select. In certain instances, if students are away, sick, injured, forget appropriate playing gear or do not turn up to meetings/trials or training, they may miss out on their opportunity to represent the College.

All information regarding team information will be conveyed via the 'Daily Notices' read out in morning Homeroom or accessed by students via the Students Portal (under Notices).

COLLEGE SWIMMING CARNIVAL

Again, this year given the current PHO, we have decided to cancel our normal carnival at Woy Woy PLC and run a **'Competitive Swimmers ONLY'** carnival on Tuesday 22 February (Week 5) at Gosford Pool.

A 'Competitive Swimmers ONLY' carnival will allow us to select our representative swimmers for the BBSSA carnival (Week 9 - Thurs 22 March).

Students will be asked to register (information regarding where to meet to register will be provided in the 'Daily Notices' details) for the carnival events during Week 3. Events include:

- 200m Freestyle (Jun [12-14yrs], Intermediate [15-16yrs] & Senior [17+yrs])
- 50m Freestyle (12-17+yrs)
- 50m Backstroke (12-17+yrs)
- 50m Breaststroke (12-17+yrs)
- 50m Butterfly (12-17+yrs)
- 100m Freestyle (12-17+yrs)

*All registered students (ONLY) will be walked down to Gosford Pool (under staff supervision) to run this selection carnival. **We ask that only serious/competitive swimmers register.** An online permission note will be sent home for each student who registers with specific information related to the day.*

All remaining students and staff will attend school as per a normal school day.

You will be notified by either BBSSSA (to compete at NSWCCC) or NSWCCC (to compete at NSW All Schools) if they have been successful. These events will not be swum at College or BBSSSA carnivals.**
