# New College

New College is a not-for-profit company that provides accommodation and care for students on-campus at The University of New South Wales. Founded in 1969, the College is actively involved in the life of the wider university community. The College pursues academic excellence, collegiality and service to society founded upon Christian faith and values. We build vibrant and close knit communities, strong in academic, sporting, cultural, social and community service activities.



## Academic Excellence

New College enjoys an outstanding academic history with 4 Rhodes Scholars, 2 General Sir John Monash Scholars and over 90 University Medallists. More than 40 percent of New Collegians receive a distinction average or higher each year. New College nurtures academic success by providing support in various forms:

- A Master and Dean who support and offer academic leadership of the College community.
- Eight resident advisers and eleven academic tutors who are available for personal and academic support.
- All the benefits of living in an affiliated college on campus at The University of New South Wales in a talented and entrepreneurial community.



## Collegiality

New College is a friendly caring community where students experience a sense of belonging and connectedness during their time at University. Influenced by the Oxbridge model of college life, the College encourages the development of the whole person- intellectually, socially and spiritually.

The college has a rich heritage and maintains links to its more than 5000 alumni, now spread around the globe, who have at some time called New College home. Living at New College is a fun, challenging and safe experience where you make lifelong friends.



## Service to Society

New College is more than just a place to live and study. There is a culture at 'New' of getting involved, leading and initiating projects that provide support and care to those in need. Whether it is putting together a team to volunteer overseas or in an Indigenous Australian Community, or helping out at a local Drop-in-Centre, New Collegians are encouraged to learn to live a life that involves more than just study and work.

## Rooms, Living & Location

Every Collegian has a private room. A small number of ensuite rooms are available. Rooms are cleaned weekly and have:

- Bed and linen (laundered weekly)
- Wardrobe and shelving
- In-room heating
- Desk, chair and reading lamp
- 40GB/month high-speed internet (100Mbps up/down) is included in room fees, with Wi-Fi throughout the whole building and Ethernet to every room. Top-up data and unlimited data plans are also available.

The rooms are arranged in a group structure. Each group has its own common room, a kitchenette with a full size fridge and separate bathrooms for men and women.

In addition to our comfortable living areas, the interior courtyard of the College is a first-class, all-weather space for studying, socialising and College events.

Other facilities include:

- The Main Common Room
- Ground Floor Lounge

- Meeting and study rooms
- Tutorial rooms with computers, printing, photocopying and scanning
- A television room with Foxtel
- The Games room
- A covered, sunlit central courtyard
- Music facilities (including a grand piano, upright piano, electric piano, drum kit and audio gear)
- A student kitchen and balcony overlooking the UNSW Village Green

New College (on campus at UNSW) is centrally located to the Airport (15 minutes), City (15 minutes), Coogee Beach (5 minutes), Maroubra Beach (10 minutes), Bondi Beach (15 minutes). Also close by, within a 10 minute walking distance, are a large number of restaurants and cafes, shops and parks, together with the UNSW Gym and Swimming Pool a short stroll away. There are bus stops located outside the UNSW main entry on Anzac Pde which go to the city, airport and beaches, and taxis are readily available.

## Meals, Dining & Cafe

Throughout the academic year, residents enjoy high quality catering (breakfast, lunch and dinner, 7 days). Meals are a vital part of College life and provide an important opportunity for meeting with fellow residents.

Lunches and dinners have hot options, as well as a salad bar, and also soups. A vegetarian option is always available. Meals are generally taken in the main dining room through the main service area, though residents are also able to eat meals in the upstairs courtyard.

Packed lunches can also be arranged for residents who need to be away from College for classes in the middle of the day.

Toast and fruit are available throughout the day. The downstairs café is open until 8:30pm each night where residents can obtain snacks, coffees and other drinks, as well as some additional meal items. Residents who miss the main meal service times are also able to obtain late meals from the café. The café also has Foxtel TV.

## Social, cultural and sporting
