- Calculates the ATAR for all NSW HSC students

Educational Access Scheme

For students with a long-term disadvantage

6 months or longer

Apply through your UAC application

Must provide supporting documents

Special consideration which may increase your selection rank

Not a guarantee of entry



Schools Recommendation Scheme

Early offer scheme through UAC

Apply online through UAC

Open to all Year 12 students

Entry based on Y11 results and school's recommendation

Unconditional offers made in November

Conditional offers can be made in November only, with conditions such as EAS eligibility or minimum ATAR



SRS Offers

- An UNCONDITIONAL offer means you have met the entry requirements and you are in
- A CONDITIONAL offer is just a notice of intent. This means that the uni will give you an offer if you meet the entry criteria
- CONDITIONS include EAS eligibility, personal statement or questionnaire, or minimum ATAR
