## Please note the following examination rules and expectations:

- Students will enter the specified examination room prior to the commencement of the examination in silence.
- Students are to make use of the time provided at recess and lunch to make use of bathroom facilities. Only
- under extreme circumstances will a student be permitted to attend the bathroom during an examination.
  Students are expected to bring all required equipment to examinations.
- Students who do not bring the required equipment (pen/pencil/ruler/eraser/calculator etc) for an examination will still be required to complete the exam and may be loaned the equipment by a teacher. In the case of not bringing equipment that supports the student in completing the task (e.g. a page of notes), the student will be required to complete the task without it. Any student who fails to bring equipment that is needed to complete the examination will receive a demerit (under Ready To Learn) from a supervising staff member. Should a student receive three demerits throughout the Examination Week, they will receive a Thursday afternoon Detention.
- Mobile phones, smart watches and other devices are not permitted in the examination room devices must be left in student schoolbags or lockers and must be switched to silent.
- Students who talk or communicate during the examination or bring notes/prompts into the examination (unless permitted) will be reported to the Director of Curriculum and face various consequences, including receiving zero for the task.
- Students are not to deface or scribble throughout the examination paper. Any cases will be reported to the relevant Leader of Learning and Director of Curriculum, who will apply consequences, including the possibility of awarding a Non-Serious Attempt.
- Students who miss a scheduled examination are required to make contact with their teacher as soon as practically possible. If a student misses an examination for a valid reason, they are required to complete the Illness/Misadventure form on the College website. All missed tasks will be required to be sat at the first available time upon the students return to school (as per the Year 10 Assessment Handbook see for more information).

## Procedures for classes around exams and at the conclusion of exams:

- Students will attend Homeroom every day as normal.
- Students will move straight to the Examination Room at the beginning of the timetabled exam do not go to your regular timetabled class first unless it is the location for your exam.
- For all exams in the ERC, students will meet on the ERC Steps. All timetabled teachers will meet at the Examination Room/ERC Steps at the start of the period also.
- Students will be directed into the ERC class-by-class, under teacher supervision. Bags will be left on the ERC Steps.
- Special Provisions Examinations will be conducted in Rooms 61-63 if this applies to you, it will be reflected on your portal. If you are receiving special provisions, go straight to the ERC Steps at the start of the exam period.
- At the conclusion of an Examination, students will move to their timetabled classroom with their timetabled teacher where they will spend the remainder of the lesson. In this time students will be permitted to work on revision/study activities for upcoming exams.
- Additionally, the following whole periods will be quarantined as opportunities for students to study/revise for upcoming exams. Classes will be in regular timetabled classrooms with regular timetabled teachers.
