PROJECT IN YOUR AREA – SEWER UPGRADE WORKS FREDERICK STREET

Central Coast Council's Water and Sewer team are working with contractors to complete an extensive works program ensuring reliable water and sewer infrastructure in the Gosford CBD that meets the needs of the community, now and in the future. With over 43% of works complete, we expect this program will be complete by early 2025 – weather permitting.

These essential water and sewer upgrades have been made possible thanks to \$42.5 million in funding through the NSW Government's Housing Acceleration Fund (HAF).

About the work

As part of this project we will be undertaking works to install a new sewer rising main and connection point within Frederick Street.

These works will involve open trenching and the laying of pipe along the western side of Frederick Street. The western lane will be closed to traffic within the works area.

Our work schedule.

The works are expected to start next Monday 26th February with completion late March 2024. Workers will start arriving onsite from 6:30am with works commencing at 7am and stopping each day at 5pm. There may be an occasion when Saturday works are required works would be undertaken from 8am to 1pm.

If we need to work outside these times, we will let affected residents know.

How will this affect you?

The western lane will be closed to traffic within the works area meaning Frederick St will be reduced to a single lane with traffic controls in place.

Works will be carried out on the western side of Frederick St (even number properties). Parking along Frederick St will be restricted, and residents may be asked to move their vehicles where necessary. Access to and from your property will be guided by contractors onsite.

You will notice additional noise and construction vehicle movements along Frederick Street. Our aim is to minimise inconvenience to you, and we thank you for your patience during these works.
