Please note the following examination rules, expectations and procedures:

- *Students will only attend school for their exams – there will be no homeroom or regular lessons.*
- *Students must arrive at the Examination Room at least 15 minutes prior to their timetabled exam. For all exams, students will meet on the Grandstand Steps.*
- *Students will be directed into the ERC course by course, under teacher supervision. Any bags brought to school must be left outside the ERC.*
- *Students will sit at their allocated desk, indicated by their name slip.*
- *Students will enter the specified examination room prior to the commencement of the examination in silence.*
- *Students are to make use of bathroom facilities before or after an examination – they will not be permitted to leave the examination room in the first hour or last 15 minutes of an exam. Only under extreme circumstances will this rule be relaxed.*
- *Students are expected to bring all required equipment to examinations.*
- *Students who do not bring the required equipment (pen/pencil/ruler/eraser/calculator etc) for an examination will still be required to complete the exam and may be loaned the equipment by a teacher. Any student who fails to bring equipment that is needed to complete the examination will receive a demerit (under Ready To Learn) from a supervising staff member. Should a student receive three demerits throughout the Examination Block, they will receive a Thursday afternoon Detention.*
- *Mobile phones, smart watches and other devices are not permitted in the examination room – devices must be left in student schoolbags or lockers and must be switched to silent.*
- *Water bottles brought into the examination room must be see-through and contain water only. No food at all in the examination room.*
- *Students who talk or communicate during the examination or bring notes/prompts into the examination (unless permitted) will be reported to the Director of Curriculum and face various consequences, including receiving zero for the task.*
- *Students are not to deface or scribble throughout the examination paper. Any cases will be reported to the relevant Leader of Learning and Director of Curriculum, who will apply consequences, including the possibility of awarding a Non-Serious Attempt.*
- *Students who miss a scheduled examination are required to make contact with Mr Butt as soon as practically possible. If a student misses an examination for a valid reason, they are required to complete the Illness/Misadventure form on the College website – ensure documentation is attached to this form (e.g. Medical Certificate, Police Report etc). All missed tasks will be required to be sat at the first available opportunity – you will be notified of this via email.*
- *Students are expected to check their email regularly throughout the Exam period – all important communication regarding changes to exams etc will be made via SEC email.*
- *Special Provisions Examinations will be conducted in Rooms 61-63 – if this applies to you, it will be reflected on your portal. If you are receiving special provisions, go straight to the ERC Steps at the start of the exam period.*
- *At the conclusion of an Examination, students will go home – if you finish an exam early you are still required to sit in the exam room for the remainder of the exam time – you will not leave early.*
