 <p>Gosford/Wyong/Woy Woy</p>	<p><b>SLES-</b> School leavers employment support (Need NDIS) Offer sample days and transition whilst at school. This includes Job searching, resume and cover letters support, work experience, TAFE, job readiness and skill building. Independent living- budgeting, cooking, travel training and learner's license. Social and community days.</p> <p><b>DES-</b> Disability Employment Service. Assist people living with disability and diverse characteristics to gain employment that makes a genuine difference for them. Whether you are seeking full-time or part-time work across any industry or role, Omnia provides the guidance and support you need to succeed – as well as build your employability through enhancing your skills.</p> <p>Job matching, Resumes and cover letters – even transport you to the interview, if required. Support with interview process and induction phase. Interview clothing. Post placement support for up to 1 year while you settle in. As you settle in, the level of support will adjust to meet your needs and can include further workplace training, ongoing support, and modifications.</p>	



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	<p>To get started, meet with one of Omnia's team members who will check your eligibility for the service, discuss your individual needs, goals and determine the best path forward, with you.</p>

Can start as young as 15.</p>	<p>NDIS Community Supports and Programs of Support available. These include Cooking, Women's Group, Men's Groups, Social Outings, Dungeons and Dragons &amp; Sports PCYC.</p> <p><b>Dungeons and Dragons-</b> Tuesday at Tuggerah 1pm-4pm. NDIS. Dungeon master won't be charged NDIS- can come and run program.</p>

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	<p><b>DES-</b> Disability employment service at Wallsend. When finished school.</p>	
 <p>Point Clare/Tuggerah</p>	<p><b>School Leavers Employment Supports (SLES):</b> Our SLES program is designed for school leavers in their final year, offering a person-centered approach to equip participants with the necessary skills to become job ready. With a focus on hands-on learning, this 2-year program is tailored to the individual needs of each participant. To be eligible to receive SLES the young person will need to have SLES funding in their NDIS plan. We are currently seeking expressions of interest to run out of the Tuggerah/ Wyong region next year depending on numbers.</p>	<p><b>Coordination of Support Level 2 (CoS):</b> Our Support Coordinators can assist in coordinating and implementing supports that enable participation in the community. This includes referrals to appropriate providers, coordinating a range of supports, and helping navigate the NDIS myplace participant portal. To be eligible to receive CoS you will need to have coordination of support in your NDIS plan.</p> <p><b>Social and Community Participation:</b> Core funding is essential for this support, and at Fairhaven, we provide various options, including onsite Hub activities, one-on-one or group community engagement, and support to attend chosen events. We have opened our new activity and movement centre at our Point Clare facility.</p> <p><b>Supported Employment:</b> We have supported employment at our Tuggerah factory and our Retail precinct. Supported employment is for individuals who require significant ongoing support in employment and is a subsidized pay system.</p>

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	<p><b>SLES- School leavers employment support (Need NDIS)</b></p> <p>The work ready SLES services is focused on employment, training and life skills for young people and school leavers. The service develops your knowledge and experience to enter the world of work, or further education with confidence.</p> <p>If still at school, you can get started with the Work Ready service.</p>
