

POST SCHOOL TRANSITION SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS WHO ACCESS THE NDIS

FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITY IN YEARS 10-12

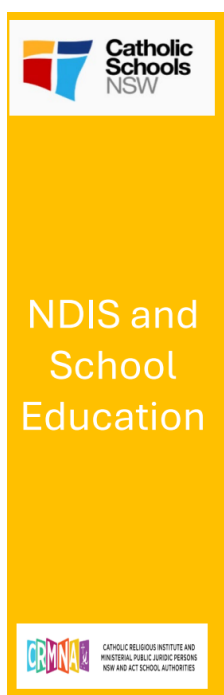
The National Disability Insurance Scheme (**NDIS**) has the ability to support **students with disability** access areas of Education, including **transitioning to training or work** in the following ways:

- Seeking part-time / casual employment
- Accessing supported work experience opportunities
- Accessing programs to support building employment skills
- Accessing VET courses
- Seeking apprenticeships

Depending on circumstances, students may be able to start accessing these services while still enrolled in school.

If eligible, the Diverse Learning team and Pastoral Care team can work together to support your son with a flexible learning plan to start the transition to post school options if this is something they are interested in.



What is NDIS responsible for?

Supports for everyday activities the student needs because of his or her disability - support needs and aren't related to learning.

This includes:

- personal care and support at school – learn more in our guideline for work and study supports
- specialist support to transition to higher education, training or work because of disability support needs.
- may also be able to fund transport to and from school, if the student cannot catch the bus because of disability
